Format of Play

Stroke Play 36 holes gross: Cat A-D Stroke Play 18 holes gross: Cat E

Ranking

Top 2 in each category qualify for the Junior Africa Challenge 2025 at South Africa and PPTV International Junior Golf Championship 2025, Bangkok, Thailand. Winners of Cat A & B (Boys and Girls) qualify for Bangladesh Amateur Open 2025 (This tournament is sponsored for four players).



Rules & Conditions

- 1. Players must compete in their own age category as on 27 Mar 2025.
- 2. For tie for 1st place, we will decide winner by sudden death playoff. If there are reasons that keep us from the play-off, eg. not enough light, bad weather or other causes that out of our control, the winner will be decided by comparing last 18, last 9, last 6 and last 3.
- 3. For tie for 2nd-5th place, we will use scorecard count back by comparing last 18, last 9, last 6, and last 3 holes aggregate scores respectively. If there still a tie, we will compare (count back) hole-by-hole score from 18th hole to 1st hole until we have the winner.

Spectator Policy

Spectators are allowed on the tournament days on conditions mentioned below:

Golf carts are allowed for spectators during practice but not on the tournament days.

Please keep quiet during the play are not give advice to the players.

If spectators/parents are not strictly following rules & condition, we will kindly ask you to wait for your player at the club house. If you are insisting of following after the warning, we reserve the right to withdraw your child from the tournament. Also, registration fee and other fees related to the tournament will not be reimbursed.

Golf Carts are allowed during the practice round only for Cat E players.

TERMS OF COMPETITION

- 1. **ORGANISER**. Greens to Glory Junior Golf Tour, India.
- 2. <u>VENUE & DATE</u>. Classic Golf & Country Club, Manesar, Haryana, India, 26-27 Mar 2025 (Wednesday to Thursday). Official Practice Round will be on 25 Jan 2025 (Tuesday) to be completed by 1500 hrs.
- 3. **ELIGIBILITY**. The Tournament is opened to all junior golfers who are under 19 years of age as on 27 Mar 2025 and similarly for their age groups. All players must be amateurs in accordance with the rules of amateur status as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and the USGA.
- 4. **FORMAT**. The Tournament shall be decided by Storke Play 36 holes gross for Category A-D players, 18 holes for Cat E players.

5. **CATEGORIES**.

Category A	15-18 Yrs (above 18 yrs can participate only for Bangladesh Amateur Open)
Category B	13-14 Yrs
Category C	11-12 Yrs
Category D	09-10 Yrs
Category E	08 Yrs & Below

6. **TIES**.

For tie for 1st place, we will decide winner by sudden death play-off. If there are reasons that keep us from the play-off, eg. not enough light, inclement weather or other causes that out of our control, the winner will be decided by scorecard count-back (Day 3)

For tie for 2nd-5th place, we will use scorecard count-back by comparing last 18, last 9, last 6, and last 3 holes aggregate scores respectively. If there still a tie, we will compare (count back) hole-by-hole score from 18th hole to 1st hole until we have the winner.

For tie for 6th place onwards, will be declared as a tie (T)

- 10. **INDEMNITY / LIABILITIES** In signing the Entry Form, participants in this Tournament shall indemnify and not hold liable, Greens to Glory, the sponsors, the organizers or the Host Club for any loss or damages to their equipment or personal belongings or harm or any form of injuries that the participants of the Tournament may suffer as a result of the participant in this Tournament.
- 11. **RULES OF PLAY** The rules of golf as approved by R & A Rules Limited and their interpretation as contained in the 'Decisions on the Rules of golf' these conditions of competition and the Golf Club Local Rules established by the Tournament Committee for the competition will apply. Disputes if any, will be settled by the Organising Committee, and a decision made by the Organising Committee will be final.
- 12. **PACE OF PLAY** The player shall play in accordance with the laid down Pace of play guidelines.
- 13. <u>DRAW</u> Tee offs for all players, shall be staggered start from Tee No's 1 and 10, as per Draw. Draw for Day 1/ Tee of timings shall be posted at the club and hotel. It will also be forwarded to the managers of team through WhatsApp. The Tournament Director reserves the right to alter the draw and change the grouping to facilitate smooth conduct of the tournament.

14. TIME OF STARTING

The Tournament Committee will make the draws and the starting times for the tournament and the same will be shared with all. Such posting will be considered sufficient notice for information and distribution.

The players shall start the play at the time laid down by the Tournament Committee. In the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in



Rule 33-7, if a player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time shall be two strokes at the starting hole. Penalty for any delay beyond five minutes is DISQUALIFICATION (Rule 6-3a).

15. TRANSPORTATION

Players must not ride on any form of transportation during a stipulated round unless authorized by the Committee.

Penalty for Breach of Condition

Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred. Maximum penalty per round: Four strokes. Use of any unauthorized form of transportation must be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. Otherwise, the player is disqualified.

SPECTATOR POLICY

16. Spectators are allowed on the tournament days on conditions mentioned below:

Golf carts are allowed for spectators during practice round only.

Please keep quiet during the play are not give advice to the players.

If spectators/parents are not strictly following rules & condition, we will kindly ask you to wait for your player at the club house. If you are insisting of following after the warning, we reserve the right to withdraw your child from the tournament. Also, registration fee and other fees related to the tournament will not be reimbursed. Golf Carts are allowed during the practice round only for Cat E players.

17. CADDIE POLICY

Players of Cat A & B – Self caddy/ Course caddy/ Private caddy.

Players Cat C & D – Caddy compulsory. Course caddy/ Private caddy.

Players Cat E - Caddy compulsory. Parent caddy/ Course caddy/ Private caddy.

18. SUSPENSION OF PLAY DUE TO DANGEROUS SITUATION (NOTE TO RULE 6-8b)

Suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signaled by a prolonged note of horn.

All other suspensions will be signaled by three consecutive short notes of a horn, repeated. In either case, resumption of play will be signaled by two short notes of a horn, repeated.

19. <u>INCLEMENT WEATHER</u>. The Committee will make every effort to complete this event in its entirety. However, The Committee reserves the right to suspend or abandon play as necessary if weather related circumstances require such action. In the unlikely event the



course is unplayable and abandons play or other conditions warranting such action, the Committee will decide the action taken for the tournament and all competitors will be informed accordingly.

- 20. **RETURN OF SCORE CARD**. A player's score card is deemed officially returned to the Committee when he has handed over his score card to the scoring official at the score recording area. **No parent or caddie is allowed in Scoring Area.**
- 21. **RESULT OF TOURNAMENT**. The results of the tournament would be updated on the website <u>www.greenstoglory.in</u> on completion of the tournament.
- 22. **ETIQUETTE, BEHAVIOUR ON THE COURSE**. The following are considered "SERIOUS BREACH OF ETIQUTTE' for this competition: -
 - (i) Usage of hand phone during a round to the annoyance and distraction of other players.
 - (ii) Verbal abuse of fellow competitors/ official/ staff.
 - (iii) Intentionally distracting or offending fellow competitors.
 - (iv) Any other 'breaches of etiquette' not listed above but are deemed to be serious by the Committee.
- 23. <u>DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE (DM)</u>. Players may use DMD, without slope mode, during the stipulated round (limited to measuring distance only). In case the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, the penalty is two strokes and DISQUALIFICATION for subsequent offence.
- 24. **<u>DISPUTES AND DOUBTFUL POINTS</u>**. Any dispute and doubtful point on the rules shall be referred to the Tournament Committee as soon as possible on the completion of the round.
- 25. **DECISIONS**. If The Committee has appointed a Referee, his decision is final (Rule 34-2). In the absence of a Referee, any dispute or doubtful point on the Rules shall be referred to the Tournament Committee, whose decision is final (Rule 34-3).
- 26. **COMPETITION CLOSED**. The championship shall be deemed to have closed when the prizes has been awarded to the winners.
- 27. Any changes to the Fact Sheet and ToC of the tournament would be the prerogative of the Organisers and would be intimated to the players.
